

Jüterbog fire brigade deploys complete range of IVECO MAGIRUS fire fighting vehicles

The brigade is continuing a long tradition as the name Jüterbog appears in the Magirus delivery records for the first time in 1935. At that time, a lance pumper tanker was delivered to the airport there.
